This is a request under the freedom of information act for the following details:

For the calendar years 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019 and 2020 to date (broken down by each year)

How many South East Coast Ambulance paramedics and other medical member of staff have taken sick leave for stress related illness?

As a consequence how many days were lost due to these staff taking leave or stress related illness?

(If it's possible within the cost limit) what is the longest period of time a paramedic or other medical member of staff has been off due to stress related illness?

To ensure we understand the context for this information - for the calendar years above can you please tell me how many paramedics were employed by the trust?

The longest period a member of front-line staff was off sick with stress related illness between 1 Jan 15 and 31 Jul 20 is **291.**
