I am writing in response to your enquiry under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) reference FOI 20/10/04.

You requested the following information, please also see our response below:

• What is the difference between summary care report and emergency care summary?

We are unable to provide a comparison as we do not use emergency care summary.

Are they accessible by the same people?

As above, we access summary care record, but nothing called a summary care report. We do not access an emergency care summary.

Who can access your summary care report(paramedics, nurses, optician, dentist?)

Summary Care Record is accessed, through our Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) system, by clinicians who work in our front-line Urgent Care Hubs, 111 Clinical Assessment Service and 999 Emergency Operations Centres. This includes nurses, paramedics, pharmacists, mental health practitioners, midwives, dental nurses and urgent care practitioners.

What is the structure of a Summary care report

Are they made to easily find information in case of emergency?

We cannot offer an opinion on this. NHS Digital design the Summary Care Record and could comment on their design intentions.
