And can you also say how many suspected suicide emergencies there have been in the first six months of this year from April to the end of September?

For the above questions please note the following:

- For question 1, values provided are from 1st April 2019 up to and including 31st March 2020.
- For Question 2, values provided are from 1st April 2020 up to and including 30th September 2020.
- Values provided are for incidents with a response. Responses- defined as incidents where at least one resource has arrived on scene.
- Please note that the condition ID associated with 'suicide' was used to identify 'suspected suicide'.
- Please treat all values with caution, as this may not always be what was identified when crew arrived at scene.
