I am writing in response to your enquiry under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) reference FOI 201103.

You requested the following information, please also see our response below:

I'm following up on some statistics from London Ambulance Service about an increase in call-outs to suicides or attempted suicides.

They say:

Figures from London Ambulance Service show crews attended an average of 37 suicides or attempted suicides a day this year compared to an average of 22 a day the year before. Five years ago the number was 17.

I'm looking to build up a national picture. Are you able to give me equivalent figures for your ambulance service

- For the year 2019 values provided are from 1st Jan 2019 up to and including 31st December 2019.

- Please note that the condition ID associated with 'suicide' was used to identify 'suspected suicide'.
- Please treat all values with caution, as this may not always be what was identified when crew arrived at scene.
