I am writing in response to your enquiry under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) reference FOI 201208.

You requested the following information, please also see our response below:

1) How many choking incidents did your ambulance service/Trust attend in 2019 and again in 2020 to date?

2019	2020

- For the year 2019 values provided are from 1st Jan 2019 up to and including 31st December 2019.
- For the year 2020, values provided are from 1st Jan 2020 up to and including 30th Nov 2020.
- The condition ID, which was identified by the call taker as the reason for the call; was used to identify choking-related calls. Please treat all values with caution, as this may not always be what was identified when crew arrived at scene.
- Please note that not every 'choking' incident is a confirmed case.
- Values provided are for incidents with a response. Responses- defined as incidents where at least one resource has arrived.
- 2) How many casualties were dead upon arrival?

 None of the incidents listed above were classed dead upon arrival.
- 3) How many casualties died on the way to hospital?

 Of the patients transported to hospital none died on route.
