- Please note these average time values relate to all categories of calls including the less serious Category 3 and 4 calls, that we aim to respond to within 90% of the time: in less than 2 hours and 3 hours respectively.
- Please note that for figures that are less than 10 we are unable to provide the exact number as it may be identifiable to individuals.
- Please note that values provided are from the 1st January 2020 up to and including 31st December 2020
