I am writing in response to your enquiry under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) reference FOI 210211.

You requested the following information, please also see our response below:

I would like to make a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act regarding the following:

How many staff, Head count, as of 01/02/21 were employed on a section 2 contract for USH payments and the breakdown for each job role.

- 2,422 based on GRS (Global Resourcing System) information.
- Please note that we are unable to provide a breakdown for each job role due to person identifiable information.

How many staff claimed USH payments in their pay claim, time sheet, for the month of January 2021 and the break down for each job role.

- Following the launch of E-Timesheets on 01/01/2021, apart from 111 staff, section 2 USH payments were not claimed as these were automatically calculated by GRS based on shifts/hours worked.
- 111 staff 354 staff claimed section 2 USH payments (January timesheets, paid February 2021)

How many staff have been moved over to section 2 due to changing their role in the organisation?

369

How many staff have changed from one role to another at the same pay band but have still been force moved to section 2 USH calculations.

How many staff have voluntarily moved over to section 2 USH and what job roles.

- Since 01/09/2018, 169 staff have opted to move to section 2 USH payments, in the following areas. Some of these no longer work for the Trust.

- EOC
- Operations
