I would like to make a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act regarding the following:

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, I am requesting the following information on incidents reported from community pharmacies relating to the Community Pharmacist Consultation Service (CPCS).

According to the <u>NHS CPCS Toolkit</u>, participating pharmacies are required to report "any incidents related to the referral process or operational issues with respect to this service to the NHS 111 provider".

As an NHS 111 provider:

- 1) Between 29 October 2019 and 28 October 2020 (inclusive), how many:
 - a. incidents relating to the CPCS referral process did community pharmacies report to your service?
