I am writing in response to your enquiry under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) reference FOI 220204.

You requested the following information, please also see our response below:

It is my understanding that training in use of Magill forceps, used when encountering a patient with a Foreign Body Airway Obstruction or FBAO, is not a compulsory requirement for all Paramedics deployed within SECAMB. Could you tell me what percentage of Paramedics deployed withing SECAMB are either trained in the use of, or qualified to a level that includes training for the use of Magill Forceps?

Ideally I would like the answer expresses as a number rather than a percentage.

All paramedics (100%) deployed within SECAmb are trained in the use of Magill forceps.
