- **Which classes of commercial insurance do the Authority currently procure (in addition to NHS Resolution risk pooling schemes)? When are these policies due for renewal?**

The Trust has the following commercial insurances in addition to the NHS Resolution risk pooling scheme.

- Personal Accident/Terrorism & Travel
- Motor Fleet (Operational + Non Operational)
- Motor Uninsured Loss Recovery
- Top-Up Buildings
- Airside Liability
- Boat
- Buildings Insurances (as part of property lease rentals)

- **How much does the Authority spend annually on its insurance premium?**

The Trust's planned spend on insurance premiums for 2022/23 for its commercial insurances including the NHS Resolution risk pooling scheme is £2,061,973 including insurance premium tax (IPT).

- **Please confirm the name of the Authority's current insurance broker/advisor (if applicable).**

Marsh provides insurance guidance and support.

- **When was the contract for insurance broking services last reviewed/tendered?**

We do not currently have a contract for brokering services.

- **When will the current contract for insurance brokerage services expire? Is this subject to a potential extension?**

Noting above, however collectively UK Ambulance Trusts (excl. Wales and Northern Ireland) are intending to scope a possible procurement for a motor insurance brokerage and support services contract during financial year 2023/24, following the renewal of current insurance provisions.
