Please can I request information as to what percentage of response capable managers (RCM's) responded to 999 calls on a daily basis over the last two vears.

This means what % were actually assigned, and arrived at scene to any 999 call.

This does not mean RCM's signed on to CAD alone.

Rationale: growing concern that RCM's are not signing on to respond Additionally,

Please can I request information as to what percentage of response capable managers (RCM's) responded to 999 calls on a daily basis over the last two years to any incident not catagorised as a C1 - Column K of the Spreadsheet.

Please see the attached spreadsheet.

- Data is only available from CAD. RCM shifts on GRS are not filled.
- All RCM responses on CAD have an on-scene time.
- On the days listed in column J, 100% of response capable managers (RCM's) responded to 999 calls on a daily basis over the last two years to any incident not categorised as a C1.
