I am writing in response to your enquiry under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) reference FOI 220705.

You requested the following information, please also see our response below:

Does the Security of Network & Information Systems Regulations (NIS Regulations) apply to the Trust or any part of the Trust (including outsourced suppliers responsible for systems defined in the Regulations)? (See here for information on the Reg: https://www.gov.uk/government/collections/nis-directive-and-nis-regulations-2018)

Under the NIS regulations the Trust is classed as an 'Operator of Essential Service' and as such are compelled to meet the requirements of the NIS directive, the DSPT is the current measurement for the Directive of which the Department of Health and Social Care is the competent authority (CA), compliance to this is seen as a form of acceptance that you are meeting your obligations. The CA or its delegated authority (NHS England) can review and direct improvements using this regulation as a driver.

- Has the Trust implemented, or is the Trust making preparations for, processes, procedures and policies related to NIS Regs?
 The Trust complies with the DSPT

 - b. If it is a current project, when do you expect it to be completed?
 - c. If no, why is it not being implemented?
