Under the Freedom of Information act 2000, I would like access to the following data from your ambulance service region: Examples of the types of standby locations and/or hubs used to by your ambulance trust to maximises its availability to respond to patients. For example, are they located at churches, lay-by's, petrol stations, etc.?

This shows all 108 sites including our 67 Ambulance Community Response Posts (ACRPs). These sites vary from standalone Portacabins, co-location in Fire Stations and Medical Centres, serviced offices such as REGUS, and previously used Ambulance Stations. Roadside standby is not frequently used by SECAmb.
