Can you please:

Tell me whether or not the incident-management software used in your control rooms is capable of accepting advanced mobile location (AML) locations for calls received via 999.

The Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) system does indeed accept the AML and allows for mobile phone locations to present to the call taker and dispatcher.

Provide copies of any instructions or guidance provided to staff in your control rooms for handling incident locations provided by callers in the form of:

- (a) Longitude and latitude coordinates.
- (b) Ordnance Survey national grid references.
- (c) What 3 Words (W3W) locations
