I am writing in response to your enquiry under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) reference FOI 220813.

You requested the following information, please also see our response below:

Under the Freedom of Information Act, could you provide me with a database extract for the period from April 1, 2022 to July 31, 2022 with data for every ambulance handover, containing columns for:

- A&E department where handover took place
- date or month of handover
- notification time or time ambulance arrived at A&E
- time handover took place/handover time/tunaround time
- level of call the ambulance was on (e.g. Category 1 etc.).

Please see the attached Data spreadsheet.

- Date range (arrival at hospital): 01/04/22 31/07/22
- Month = Month of arrival at hospital
- HandoverDuration = Time from arrival at hospital to time handover recorded
- TurnaroundDuration = Time from arrival at hospital to time clear
- Priority = Incident priority. HCP relates to an incident deemed suitable to wait up to 4 hours that was arranged by a healthcare professional.
- The recording of a handover time is a manual process so not every transport will have a handover time.
- Please note that a category of a call relates to how the call was triaged at the time of the 999 call and is not a direct indication of a patient's condition on arrival at hospital.
