You requested the following information, please also see our response below:

I am writing to you under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 to request the following information from your Ambulance Trust. Please may you provide me with:

1. The average time taken for a handover between ambulances and A&E, broken down by year since 2010.

2. The total time taken for a handover between ambulances and A&E, broken down by year since 2010.

3. The number of handovers between ambulances and A&E, broken down incrementally by hour, from 1st January 2021 to 31st December 2021.

## Please provide the data in a table format.

The Hospital Handover Time Stamp data pre 2017 is inconsistently recorded and does not provide sufficient data due to the process of relying on the manual entry of a handover pin by both the crew and hospital staff. The process has changed to a single entry and data is now more consistently recorded. 2022 data is until 31st July 2022.
