Dear,

I am writing in response to your enquiry under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) reference FOI 221134b.

You requested the following information, please also see our response below:

Given there is virtually no one in East Preston who is above the rail line just give me the Stats for East Preston and West Kingston. Between 5am and 11pm (to avoid night C2 times when few trains run making the stats look good)
So

Please tell me the mean C2 times for a period of say the last 6 months in total for EP and Kingston West Kingston. (i.e. those who have ambulances stuck at the crossing frequently) between 5am and 11pm

The parishes are well defined and both can only be reached through the crossing gates or a massive detour either to more gates at Angmering station or a bridge in Rustington.

So I expect a one line reply.

C2 meantime for EP and West Kingston between 5am and 11pm = X minutes

C2 being an emergency I assume.

That's simple enough isn't it?

Clearly that does not identify anyone does it?

I am right in assuming you don't delete important data and you keep full logs?

If your dataset is small, say just 1 person in a whole month, you need to increase the period until it reaches a level where no one could derive an individual.

One line is now all I require.
