I am writing in response to your enquiry under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) reference FOI 230167.

You requested the following information, please also see our response below:

Under the Freedom of Information Act of 2000, please can you provide me with the following information:

I understand the need for disclosure because this has come as an FOI. We only require the counts by LSOA with no characteristics. We had been liaising with a SECAMB colleague who said we would have to put in an FOI request. Here is a summary of how the data will be used: I am currently working on a project to help with Alcohol licensing responsibilities. Public Health now have a duty Under the Licensing Act to respond to alcohol licensing reviews if they feel the proposals could cause further harm. In order to provide consistent evidence and therefore responses to these reviews, a simple tool was developed that looked at a number of LSOA level data sets for example hospital admissions, crimes data and assesses alcohol harm. We are currently in the process of updating it for Hampshire and the Isle of Wight. Thank you in advance. If this is not possible, please can I request that we have the data by MSOA rather than LSOA.
