3) For those 999 calls which your service gave a high priority classification to, and where an ambulance or paramedic was deployed, what was the average time from the call being received in your control room, to the ambulance or paramedic reaching their deployment destination, in the years 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018,, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022 and 2023

4) For those 999 calls which your service gave a high priority classification to, and where an ambulance or paramedic was deployed, and a casualty was assessed as requiring urgent hospital treatment, what was the average time from arrival outside an Accident and Emergency department, to the casualty being treated within the Accident and Emergency department, in the tears 2015, 2016, 2017, 2017, 2019, 202, 2021, 2022 and 2023.
