We care about the impact we're having on the environment and so we are committed to reducing our emissions by 50% by 2032 and achieving net zero by 2040.

Did you know that one tonne of CO₂e at room temperature has the volume of a large hot air balloon? Or that our annual emissions are the equivalent of driving a car around the globe 17,500 times?



Our near-term target is:

7,389
tCO₂e
by 2032

To reduce our carbon emissions from 14,778 tCO₂e to 7,389 tCO₂e by 2032.

We will be focusing on:

Fleet



Our fleet is responsible for **63%** (9,236 tCO₂) of our carbon emissions

We will be transitioning to ultra-low emission and zero emissions electric vehicles by 2032, starting with three fully electric SRVs in 2023.

Medicine



Our medicines account for **10%** (1,504 tCO₂) of our carbon emissions

We will be exploring greener alternatives to delivering medical equipment and gases while also ensuring we don't compromise patient care.

Estates



Our Estates is responsible for **15%** (2,146 tCO₂) of our carbon emissions

We're committed to delivering energy-saving measures such as moving to solar PV and battery storage, retrofit double glazing, roof insulation and LED lighting.

Network



We're supporting our Green Champion Network to progress a number of carbon-saving initiatives such as:

- Removing paper cups across our Trust,
- Introducing recyclable material to patients' plastic medication bags,
- Funding a sustainability course.
