No. of patients where at least one dose of Naloxone was recorded on the electronic patient care record (ePCR) and count of ePCRs that have more than one dose recorded.

The electronic patient clinical record was gradually introduced from August 2019, with most crews having adopted by April 2020. Prior to this, reporting is based on a freetext field on the paper PCR which is scanned into the database. This comes with a degree of error.
