I am writing in response to your enquiry under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) reference FOI 240925.

You requested the following information, please also see our response below:

My FOI request is below -

Dear.

1. Is it known there is inequality between how 2 members of staff on the same AFC banding are paid due to differences with Section 2 unsociable hours payments and Annexe 5 unsociable hours payments, despite performing the same role?

The NHS introduced Section 2 Unsocial Hours into the Ambulance Service in 2018 as part of a contract refresh aligning ambulance services with the rest of the NHS. It was a process agreed Nationally between NHSE and Unions. Section 2 pays a higher unsocial hours percentage than Annexe 5, whilst Annexe 5 affords protection to pay (in sickness) which Section 2 does not.

2. Has the trust been paying those on Section 2 the correct amount of unsociable hours or is there recalculations and backpay due?

The Trust has been applying Section 2 based on its interpretation of Agenda for Change. We are in discussions with unions colleagues regarding this.

3. Is there a plan within the Trust to offer staff an option to change back to Annexe 5 and to whom will it be offered to, and when?

There is no plan to offer an option to return to Annexe 5. Agenda for Change set out that a change of role resulting in a new contract (promotion for example) requires colleagues to move to Section 2.
