I am writing in response to your enquiry under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) reference FOI 230910.

You requested the following information, please see our response below:

please could I ask for the following:

1. Is it your policy to send x4 Paramedics, or X2 crews (Para Technician, or other) to Cardiac arrest calls?

Our policy is neither, it's to send 4 'pairs of hands', one of which must be a paramedic.

2. Are there any instances over the last 12 months whereby you have sent x1 crew to a cardiac arrest?

Yes. In certain cases, when the initial ambulance arrives before additional resources are dispatched, they may find the patient in a condition unrelated to cardiac arrest or not compatible with commencing resuscitation (such as a condition unequivocally associated with death or a valid and applicable advance decision to refuse treatment, specifically refusing CPR).
