The number of risks assessments conducted on children where there was concern that the had been the victim of child sexual exploitation (using the same timeframe as above).

Details of your NHS Trusts' CSE safeguarding arrangements, including work in multi-agency partnerships.

The number of staff employed by your NHS Trust who have received training on CSF.

## **Formal Response**

The Trust confirms it holds the information you requested.

The number of referrals made by your NHS Trust to other authorities – such as the police or social services – when there was a suspicion that a child is a victim of exploitation (sexual, criminal, gang-based grooming) for the years 2010 (or earliest available year of data) – 2024 inclusive.



1/1/24-20/5/25 – 33 Referrals have been made for children under the categories of Child Sexual Exploitation and Modern Slavery. Our system does not have the functionality however to identify other criminal or gang-based grooming concerns as these are not concern categories that we currently record. It is likely that concerns of this type have been raised, but coded under other categories, such as Emotional, Financial or Physical Abuse.

The number of risks assessments conducted on children where there was concern that the had been the victim of child sexual exploitation (using the same timeframe as above).

None. As an ambulance service, we do not undertake any case work with our patients or have any ongoing therapeutic relationship. Therefore, we do not conduct any risk assessments other than determining the need for onward referral to an agency who can, such as social services or the police.

Details of your NHS Trusts' CSE safeguarding arrangements, including work in multi-agency partnerships.

The Trust references CSE in its Safeguarding Policy and Procedure and safeguarding training at level 2 and 3. The Trust sits on Safeguarding Children Partnerships across Kent, Surrey and Sussex and contributes to priority areas including CSE. The Trust has a mechanism to place markers on our CAD (Computer Aided Dispatch) System if we are informed a child is at risk of CSE and may come into contact with the ambulance service.

The number of staff employed by your NHS Trust who have received training on CSE.

4,498 members of the workforce have received training on CSE.
