FOI Request

You asked us:

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, please can you disclose the following information:

- 1. The number of ambulance staff/paramedics who have been injured while on duty in the last three years. (Broken down by FY 2022/23, 2023/24, 2024/25) 1a) Broken down by injury causes (e.g. slip/trip/fall, road traffic incident, assault) (Broken down by same years as above).
- 1b) Broken down by injury severity (slight, serious, fatal) (Broken down by same years as above).
- 1c) Broken down by location/area where the injury occurred. (Broken down by same years as above).

Formal Response

The Trust confirms it holds part of the information you requested. This information cannot be restricted to represent only paramedics or staff that work in ambulances.

The Trust has extracted data from an internal incident reporting system. Numbers of incidents include those reported as affecting any staff member, and is under a category related to sustaining injuries or suffering physical assaults. These incidents are reported by individual staff members; accuracy of any data output reflects only the accuracy with which individual reports were made.

The Trust can provide a breakdown of the category of incident. The incident reporting database was upgraded during Quarter 4 of 2023/24, so prior to this the categorisation was more limited. Some categories – although similar – cannot be equated across the years, so have been left separate.
