Listed time and date breakdowns of medical personnel attendance within the vicinity of Crowborough Army Camp region (+0.5 miles) between the 22nd January 2026 and todays' date (17th February 2026)

For any events involving medical attendance to, or within the Crowborough Army Camp site itself, further details of the requirement of presence to the site alongside the nature of the request/allocation of resource.

The number of Service Users of Crowborough Army Camp that have received off-site medical attendance from The Trust up to todays date (17th February 2026)

If Service Users of Crowborough Army Camp have used The Trusts' Resources and not the on-site resource of Crowborough Army Camp, the requirement for them to be treated off-site

If there is any clarification needed on the request details above then please let me know.



Formal Response

All the data for this question is for cases where the incident Location was like '**Crowborough Army Camp**' or the Incident Location Postcode was either '**TN6 3SX**' or '**TN6 1UB**'. Due to the small count of cases, we cannot provide the nature of the requests/allocation of resource due to the potential risk of sharing Patient Identifiable Data.

* Data blurring at less-than-5: The Trust can confirm that this information exists. However, where an output represents fewer than 5 individuals or incidents in the period requested, we have not provided exact figures. This practice is known as data blurring, which serves to mitigate against the risk of possible re-identification of individual data subjects via data recombination (sometimes referred to as jigsawing). This risk is assessed in accordance with the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) Anonymisation Code of Practice.
