The Trust is withholding part of the information within this request. This information is withheld under **Section 43(2)** of the Freedom of Information Act 2000. This exemption applies where disclosure would, or would be likely to, prejudice the commercial interests of the Trust or its suppliers.

Releasing detailed information about the Trust's mobile device management system, Microsoft licence pricing, and contractual renewal dates would reveal sensitive commercial data relating to our digital estate and negotiated licence agreements. Public disclosure would:

- Weaken the Trust's ability to secure competitive pricing in future procurements;
- Undermine the commercial position of the Trust's suppliers by revealing negotiated rates not available on the open market; and
- Risk creating unfair advantage for competitors during future tendering exercises.

The Trust is withholding the name of the mobile device management product under **Section 31(1)(a)**. Disclosure of detailed technical information about our mobile device management systems would increase the risk of malicious cyber activity by helping hostile actors understand the Trust's digital security configuration. This would compromise the Trust's ability to prevent and detect crime, including cyber-attacks.
