Thank you for your request for information, which we received on **27/02/2026**. We have considered your request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. **Please ensure you quote the Internal Reference number above in any future correspondence.**

Your Request

I would like to have a list of all current Ambulance Stations in your area. HART Stations too if applicable.

Any building where a vehicle would be regularly stationed to be dispatched from, or a building where a vehicle would regularly start and/or end their shift.

Formal Response

In accordance with section 21 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, which exempts information that is already reasonably accessible to the applicant by other means, we are unable to provide a list of current Ambulance Stations, Portacabins, Ambulance Community Response Posts (ACRPs), and Hazardous Ambulance Response Team (HART) Stations directly in response to your request. This is because the information you have sought is routinely published and publicly available via the South East Coast Ambulance Service NHS Foundation Trust [website](#).

Section 21 provides that a public authority is not obliged to provide information if it is already accessible to the applicant, whether or not the information is free of charge. We have assessed your request and determined that the information regarding all buildings regularly used for vehicle dispatch or shift start/end, including HART Stations where applicable, can be accessed without restriction on our official Trust



website. This exemption applies regardless of the format or manner in which the information is available, as long as it is accessible to you.

If you are dissatisfied with the Trust's response to your request, you have the right to ask for an internal review.

The internal review will be conducted by an individual who was not directly involved in handling your original request, ordinarily the Trust's Data Protection Officer. We aim to complete internal reviews within **20 working days** of receipt.

If you remain dissatisfied following the outcome of the internal review, you may complain to the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO). The ICO generally expects complaints to be raised promptly following the completion of an internal review.
