SECAmb has a Council of Governors which consists of 25 people:

- 14 Public Governors, elected by our members
- 4 Staff Governors, elected by staff
- 7 Appointed Governors, from organisations SECAmb works closely with, including a local authority, a charity, a mental healthcare provider, a community trust, the police and a local acute hospital.

In a nutshell, Governors ensure our Trust is putting patients, employees and volunteers at the heart of it's decision making.

We act as 'critical friends', offering constructive challenge, via the Non-Executive Directors.
