You requested the following information:

Could you please provide me with digital copies of your current publications relevant to your Ambulance/Community First Responder Scheme for example:

a. Volunteer Agreement.

b. Protocols for deployment, training and treatment of patients.

Please see our Deployment Model attached, titled support desk trial. We are currently reviewing our training and are unable to provide formally agreed training plans at this time.

c. List of approved, equipment, gasses and drugs.

An order form to evidence CFR kit is attached. In addition to these items CFRs carry an Automated External Defibrillator (AED), oxygen, salbutamol, aspirin, thermometer, peak flow, pulse oximeter and manual blood pressure kit.

d. First Responder Strategy.

There is no formal strategy at present and this is in the process of being produced.
