I am writing in response to your enquiry under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) reference FOI/15/01/31.

You requested the following information:

Please provide the percentages of patients treated at the scene , those taken to A & E and those taken to other health or social care providers over the last two years.

Please see the table below which shows the number of incidents South East Coast Ambulance Service NHS Foundation Trust responded to in 2013 and 2014 broken down into those where the patient was:

- i) treated on scene,
- ii) taken to a hospital with a 24 hour consultant led A & E department, unfortunately we are not able to differentiate between transports to the A&E department and other departments such as Cardiac or Maternity on site.
- iii) taken to other locations i.e. smaller hospitals, walk in centres, urgent care centres.
