I am writing in response to your enquiry under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) reference FOI/15/02/24.

You requested the following information:

In 2014, in your ambulance Trust, how many ambulance call-outs were delayed by a request for a police escort?

I regret to advise that we cannot provide any information as requested on the grounds of the exemption contained within s.12 of the FOIA. To retrieve the information requested above would necessitate manually searching through the comments section of each response made of which there were over 650,000 in 2014, to see if there were any comments about a police escort being required. This would exceed the appropriate limit of 18 hours as set down in the guidance on the application of the Freedom of Information and Data Protection (Appropriate Limit and Fees).

I am sorry that I cannot be of more help on this occasion.
