I am writing in response to your enquiry under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) reference FOI/15/07/24.

How much funding has SECamb received from the Department of Health for the Hazardous Area Response Team(s) (HART) since 'set up' and how much of that funding was allocated for training/ education?

South East Coast Ambulance Service NHS Foundation Trust has received a total of £24.8m from the Department of Health over the last 5 years for HART (Hazardous Area Response Team) since set up. The table showing the breakdown for each year is shown below:

2010-11	0.2
2011-12	4.3
2012-13	6.5
2013-14	6.6
2014-15	6.5
Total	24.8

Unfortunately we only hold records on funding allocated for training/ education from April 2013 onwards.
