I am writing in response to your enquiry under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) reference FOI/15/09/28.

You requested the following information:

I would to know, for Maidstone, how many times 1 ambulance was sent out to a call, 2 ambulances were sent, 3 ambulances etc up until the highest amount of ambulances.

I would like this information to be broken down by the nature of the illness/emergency.

I would like this information for 1 Sep 2013-1 Sep 2014, and 1 Sep 2014-1 Sep 2015 separately.

Please see the attached spreadsheet which shows the number of resources at an incident from the highest to the lowest together with the nature of the problem they were attending as generated by our call takers following information noted during the 999 call. The resources would include helicopter emergency services, double crewed ambulances, Single response Vehicles, Community First Responders and our Hazardous Area Response Team vehicles. This information is based on the Local Authority area of Maidstone and the parliamentary wards contained within.
