I am writing in response to your enquiry under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) reference FOI/15/11/33.

You requested the following information:

Please could you confirm the names of the private ambulance providers that were added to the current framework in 2014 to provide A&E services and those added to the framework for PTS services?

South East Coast Ambulance Service NHS Foundation Trust has one framework for Private Ambulance Providers (PAPs) which commenced in June 2014. This covers A & E and PTS.

No PAP's or PTS were added to the current /existing framework.

Could you confirm the date of the start of the framework for PAPs for both A & E and PTS services in 2014.

June 2014

Do all private ambulance providers have to be CQC registered at the time of being added to either framework?

Yes.

We have robust governance arrangements in place for the procurement of private ambulance services. While working on our behalf any private provider will be subject to a continuous monitoring and assessment process, to ensure they are providing a high level of service.

The Trust continues to look at ways in which we can reduce our reliance on the use of private ambulance services and always prioritise using our own staff whenever possible. However, along with all ambulance services nationally, South East Coast Ambulance Service NHS Foundation Trust (SECAmb) does use private ambulance providers when faced with high levels of demand, when experiencing high call volume or during periods of bad weather.



Could you confirm which private ambulance providers remain on both frameworks at this time (18/11/15) and if any have been added since it started in 2014?
