I am writing in response to your enquiry under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) reference FOI/15/11/08.

You requested the following information:

Please could you provide us with a list of patients in the Surrey and North Hampshire area who have been diagnosed with heart attack and have been taken to the local PCI centre for the last 3 years. We will need to know the arrival date of the patient, PCI centre/hospital that the patient was taken to, postcode of the patients address and town.

Please see the attached spreadsheet which shows the first four digits of the post code from where the patient was picked up from.

The attached data was compiled using MINAP (Myocardial Infarction National Audit Project) data, which records SECamb incidents where patients were taken to hospital for pPCI consideration. There was an initial total of 2322 incidents for designated hospitals used in the Surrey/North Hants area, however 183 incidents were removed as either an incident number was not recorded or an incorrect incident number was quoted.
