Please see attached our spreadsheet which shows the number of emergency responses made to the above mentioned South West train stations during the period of the financial year 2014/2015 and from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2015 to 30<sup>th</sup> November 2015. This information has been located by using the following NHS Pathways categories; Cardiac arrest, Cardiac/ respiratory arrest, chest pain/ cardiac problem and chest/upper back pain, palpitations. These categories have been determined by the Emergency Medical Adviser whilst triaging the 999 call.

I have only listed the month of the responses as due to there being so few responses at some stations, to supply the date and time may potentially provide patient identifiable information.
