I am writing in response to your enquiry under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) reference FOI/16/01/05.

You requested the following information:

How many of your ambulances/ other vehicles have been involved in collisions over the last three financial years? Please break down by 2012-13, 2013-14, and 2014-15.

Please also break down, again by each year:

i) how many of these incidents occurred during emergency calls, and how many did not

Please see the attached spreadsheets from 2012 through to November 2015 which show the total numbers of road traffic collisions involving our vehicles. The spreadsheets show the date of the collision, the type of vehicle involved, the collision type and the journey type.

ii) how many injuries and fatalities were caused, and whether these were your employees, or members of the public.

(If you hold any information relating to the type

iii) Please include the type of vehicle in each instance (e.g. ambulance, motorbike) and the cost of repair.

Unfortunately I regret to advise that we cannot provide any information on injuries, fatalities or cost of repairs as requested on the grounds of the exemption contained within s.12 of the FOIA. To retrieve this information would necessitate manually searching through each accident record to locate these details. This would exceed the appropriate limit of 18 hours as set down in the guidance on the application of the Freedom of Information and Data Protection (Appropriate Limit and Fees).

The information I wish to receive also relates to incidents where one of your vehicles was involved in an collision where the vehicle was not damaged (but, for instance, where someone may have been injured, or another vehicle or property was damaged).

To add - by 'collisions' - I mean bumps and scrapes with objects and people, as well as other vehicles.

The blank spaces on the spreadsheet indicate where we have not been advised of this information. This list contains all reported collisions (as staff are required to do) including very minor incidents causing minimum vehicle damage. The figures on the spreadsheet should be seen in the context of the number of miles travelled by our vehicles in the whole of the SECamb (South East Coast Ambulance Service NHS Foundation Trust) area which covers Kent, Surrey, Sussex and North East Hampshire. Please see the table below showing the mileage for all the vehicles responding to incidents in the SECamb area.
