I am writing in response to your enquiry under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) reference FOI/16/01/15.

You requested the following information:

Please advise me of the number of applications for promotions, training and job applications that have been blocked or referred due to Sickness monitoring.

I have checked with our recruitment and learning and development departments and both have advised that unfortunately they do not hold this information in a reportable format.

I regret to advise that we cannot provide any further information as requested on the grounds of the exemption contained within s.12 of the FOIA. To retrieve the information would necessitate manually searching through all applications for promotions, training and jobs and locating the names of the staff who had applied to check their personnel files. This would exceed the appropriate limit of 18 hours as set down in the guidance on the application of the Freedom of Information and Data Protection (Appropriate Limit and Fees).

I am sorry that I cannot be more helpful on this occasion.
