I am writing in response to your enquiry under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) reference FOI/16/01/18.

You requested the following information:

Can you please confirm how many of the short-notice, on-day transport requests you receive from GPs, or are asked to provide in order to support same day appointments for rapid access services (which I believe are also referred to as "GP Urgents") that SECamb delivered during 2014/15 as part of its Emergency Transport Contract were supported by crews employed to deliver your Non-Emergency Patient Transport Service (PTS)?

I can confirm that our Patient Transport Services staff undertook 404 journeys on behalf of A & E. These were HCP requests for patients to be transported to hospital and were undertaken by a whole range of staff.
