Do you provide training to both clinical and non-clinical staff on managing refugees and asylum seekers?

Are there any plans being developed to provide training for staff around refugees and asylum seekers?

We haven't carried out any training specifically for non - clinical staff on managing refugees and asylum seekers, and as far as we are aware, we have no immediate plans to do so.



With regards to training our Emergency Care Support Workers (ECSWs), we currently do not have a specific session for these groups of patients. During Corporate Induction staff will receive a session on SECAmb values including Equality and Diversity awareness. As well as this, all staff are required to complete an annual e-learning package as part of their key skills. We currently have no plans to include specific education packages for this group of patients over and above our current arrangements.
