Will be introduced in April 2016, (adults and children)

b) Epistatus (midazalem maleate)

No (adults and children)

c) Rectal Diazapam

Yes (adults and children)

1. What is the process to get a new medicine on the Ambulance Trust Formulary?

Proposals are heard by our drug and therapeutic group and ratified by the Trust's Risk Management Group.
