I am writing in response to your enquiry under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) reference FOI/16/03/11.

You requested the following information:

I am applying for the information below for each of the financial years listed (where possible):

2006/7, 2007/8, 2008/9, 2009/10, 2010/11, 2011/12, 2012/13, 2013/14 and 2014/15.

## • The total number of calls attended;

Please see the table below which shows the number of emergency responses made during the financial years 2006/2007 to 2014/2015. This information is based on data directly from our information system. The final activity values issued as part of SECAmbs contract reporting process may vary slightly against this.

## • The number of calls attended where alcohol was a factor/involved;

Unfortunately we cannot capture a full data set for the requested information. However, please see the table below which shows the number of emergency responses made, based on the number of calls received where following triage of the call it has been categorised as 'alcohol intoxication' or 'alcohol related' according to NHS Pathways. We only hold this detail of information from 2011/2012 when NHS Pathways was introduced.

Please note that these figures may not include all responses made where alcohol was a factor. These may be categorised under other pathways conditions such as trauma, unconscious or limb injuries. I regret to advise that we cannot provide any further information on these incidents on the grounds of the exemption contained within s.12 of the FOIA. To retrieve the information would necessitate manually searching through all categories to identify if any other incidents were alcohol related. This would exceed the appropriate limit of 18 hours as set down in the guidance on the application of the Freedom of Information and Data Protection (Appropriate Limit and Fees).

I would like to stress that these figures are based on the information provided by the caller which may prove different to what our crews find when they reach the patient, therefore the detail given by the caller may not always be accurate.
