I am writing in response to your enquiry under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) reference FOI/16/03/28.

You requested the following information:

I was wondering if you knew at all how many times ambulances have been called to the University of Kent Canterbury campus over the course of the past five academic years, divided by year. (September 2011 to June 2012, September 2012 to June 2013, September 2013 to June 2014, September 2014 to June 2015, September 2015 to June 2016).

Please see the table below which shows the number of emergency responses made to the University of Kent for the requested periods and up to and including March 2016. This information is based on searching under 'University of Kent' rather than the different postcodes within the university and includes all areas of the university including the sports centre and student accommodation.
