I am writing in response to your enquiry under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) reference FOI/16/10/10.

You requested the following information:

Q1. How many 999 calls were responded to by your Trust between September 2015 and September 2016?

I can confirm that South East Coast Ambulance NHS Foundation Trust made 729,703 emergency responses during the period from 1st September 2015 to 31st August 2016.

Q2. How many of the responses made during this period were classed as Mental Health?

Of the 729,703 responses made 21,087 were classed as mental health or mental health issues. However I must make you aware that this is based on the information provided by the caller during the 999 call and this may be different to what the ambulance crews find when they reach the patient.
