I am writing in response to your enquiry under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) reference FOI/17/01/05.

You requested the following information:

Under the Freedom of Information Act, I would like to make a request for information concerning fire crew being called to assist SECAmb with medical emergencies recently.

Please could I be sent the following information

1- How many times fire crew from across Kent were called to help SECAmb between November 30 2016 to 2nd January 2017.

Fire First responders were mobilised a total of 142 times by SECAmb from November 30 2016 to 31st December 2016 inclusive. January numbers will be available February 2017 after validation. I would like to add that these figures are in addition to the responses we would routinely request Fire Service assistance at e.g. RTC's, Entrapments etc.

2- The most frequent kind of medical emergency they were called out to attend e.g. RTC.

Cardiac/Respiratory Arrest

3- If SECAmb weren't present at any of the incidents alongside the fire service.

4- What kind of assistance they provided.

As per contractual guidelines, From May 2016, the Fire First Response will respond to Red 1 and Red 2 calls only.
