How many mental health related call outs (e.g. categories such as psychiatric, abnormal behaviour, suicide attempt, self harm, etc) the Trust has received in 2016?

Please give the total figure for 2016.

Please then break this figure down and give a figure per county that the service covers.

Please see the table below which shows the emergency responses made to incidents where the problem nature was indicated as those mentioned in your question above. I would like to stress that these figures are based on the information provided to the call taker during triage of the 999 call and may not be what the crew find when they reach the patient.
