Please can you give me details of how many of your paramedics and emergency care assistants have taken time of work due to stress in the financial year 2016 - 2017 and in the current financial year to date (latest figures available).

Can you tell me:

- the number of members of staff who took time off due to stress
- the total number of days they took off between them

We do not have Emergency Care Assistants, but we have included the figures for Emergency Care Support Workers which are the equivalent.

The table below shows the number of staff who took time off due to stress.

Emergency Care Support Workers	44	12



The table below shows the total number of days they took off between them:
