I am writing in response to your enquiry under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) reference FOI/17/08/30.

You requested the following information, please also see our response below:

* How many call-outs did the SECAmb attend due to a patient having taken a semi-synthetic or synthetic opioid in the last four financial years (2013-14, 2014-15, 2015-16, 2016-17 and 2017-18 to date (I realise this is an incomplete year)? Please can you break down the last two financial years (2016-17 and 2017-18 to date) by month.

* For each year, can you also provide a breakdown of the semi-synthetic or synthetic opioid that was taken leading to an ambulance call out (eg fentanyl, oxycodone, morphine)

• For each year, can you also provide information about why the ambulance was called (eg there were 10 call outs due to overdose/ allergic reaction etc).

Unfortunately to extract the information you requested above would require going through each individual record and exceed 18hours and would therefore fall under Section 12- FOI (Appropriate limit and fees) Regulations 2004
