I am writing in response to your enquiry under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) reference FOI/17/09/02.

You requested the following information, please also see our response below:

For the calendar year 2017 to date - how many South East Coast Ambulance paramedics have taken sick leave for stress related illness?

From 1st January to 31st July 2017 - 54 Paramedics had at least one period of sickness absence due to stress related illness

As a consequence, how many days were lost due to paramedics taking leave or stress related illness?

From 1st January to 31st July 2017 – 1526.73 FTE days were lost to paramedic sickness absence due to stress related illness

(If it's possible within the cost limit) what is the longest period of time a paramedic has been off due to stress related illness?

From 1st January to 31st July 2017 - The longest episode of sickness absence due to stress related illness was for 276 calendar days

To ensure we understand the context for this information - for the calendar year above can you please tell me how many paramedics were employed by the Trust?

The headcount for paramedics as at 31 July 2017 was 836 (773.16 FTE)
